

# **One Mile – One Flag – One Hero** September 27 - 29, 2013, 5<sup>th</sup> Annual NJ Run

In an apolitical reflection of remembrance a team of 32 active duty military personnel from Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst and other bases across the country will come together to embark on a 186 mile run that honors every NJ service member killed in support of Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, New Dawn and all Wars and Conflicts. Each mile of the Run is dedicated to a NJ Hero and their family. The run team will stop at each Hero Marker presenting a flag and personalized biography to waiting loved ones and comrades. With the intent to create a 186 mile memorial trail across New Jersey.

DAY 1 – Starts Friday, September 27, 2013, 8:00 am, at the Cape May Lighthouse.

**DAY 2** – (Atlantic County) starts Saturday September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013, 6:30 am, in the Sandi Pointe Bistro Parking Lot, 908 Shore Rd, Somers Point, NJ and it ends in Atlantic County at 10:30 am, at Hero Marker 70, in Port Republic near the Chestnut Neck Battle Creek Monument.

Note: The NJRFTF Organization is requesting for Legion Riders who wish to be at each Hero Marker ride in front of the advance Run For The Fallen Party, not in front of the Run For The Fallen Team and that no more than three (3) veterans to be present at each Hero Marker.

Gary Sinise, the actor who played Lt. Dan in the 1993 movie "Forrest Gump," has been named an Honorary Marine. Gen. James F. Amos, the Marine Corps commandant, said Sinise earned the recognition because of his efforts to support military veterans. "There is little I can say to enhance the rich reputation Gary Sinise has earned," Amos said during a ceremony at the Marine Corps Barracks in



Washington, D.C., on Thursday. "What I can do, what I am privileged and proud to do, is to recognize this humble patriot's selfless service by making him an Honorary Marine." According to a Marine Corps press release, Sinise was "totally surprised" by the honor he received. "I'm humbled, shocked, moved and motivated to keep standing up for our men and women (in uniform) and giving back to them," Sinise was reported as saying. Sinise, who regularly performs with his band, The Lt. Dan Band, also heads The Gary Sinise Foundation, which exists to honor "defenders, veterans, first responders, their families, and those in need," according to the foundation's website. "We do this by creating and supporting unique programs designed to entertain, educate, inspire, strengthen, and build communities," the website said.

According to the Marine Corps release, other notable people who share the title of Honorary Marine with Sinise are actor Chuck Norris and Pulitzer prize-winning photographer Joe Rosenthal.




